## Perspective from the Pew



By the time you are reading this, a new liturgical season began. Advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming." Jesus is coming, and Advent is intended to be a season of preparation for His arrival. While we typically regard Advent as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a period of preparation, much like Lent. Prayer, penance and fasting are appropriate during this season.

Advent is not as strict as Lent, and there are no rules for fasting, but it is meant to be a period of self-preparation. The color violet, associated with Advent is also the color of penance. The faithful should fast during the first two weeks in particular and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The color of the Third Sunday of Advent is rose. This color symbolizes joy and represents the happiness we will experience when Jesus comes again. The Third Sunday is a day of anticipatory celebration. It was formerly called "Gaudete" Sunday; Gaudete means "rejoice" in Latin.

We often miss Advent's power because these December weeks are full of secular Christmas parties and preparations for Christmas. Each year, the busyness of this season serves to distract us from having an Advent season that truly prepares us for the celebration of Christmas, with all its meaning.

Advent has just begun, there is still time to participate, and if you are looking for some suggestions, well say no more, here are a few:

Advent Wreath – Read the Gospel for the Sunday before lighting.

Advent Dinners – Prepare a nice dinner, or host a potluck and invite family and friends.

Advent Devotional Reading – There are a lot of great Advent Books, pick one, get it, and begin reading it. Try to finish before the season ends.

Special Prayers – Some can be found in Advent Devotional Books. If you don't choose that option, try St. Andrew Christmas Novena.

Advent Calendars – Good way to celebrate with children.

Advent Music – Google Resources for Liturgy and prayer for the Season of Advent and Christmas.

Nativity Scenes – To make the display especially poignant, wait until Christmas Eve to place the Baby Jesus into the scene. The Vatican has a neat tradition of the Holy Father blessing the Baby Jesus from family nativity scenes, called Bambinelli Sunday.

Jesse Tree – This is a fun Biblical activity during Advent season. It goes through the ancestry of Jesus and how all of his ancestors played a role in salvation history.

Small Sacrifices for the Christ Child – Because Advent is known as the "little Lent," prayer, alms, and sacrifices are also a part of Advent season. Just as the Magi labored through a long journey to worship and gave precious gifts to the Christ Child, so we can do the same; we can give the Baby Jesus our sacrifices during the Advent season.
