## Perspective from the Pew



Another Easter has come to pass, and of course by now we are well in the Easter season. Recently, I was reflecting upon the Holy Gospel according to Saint John while waiting for Mass to begin, and this particular passage was stuck in my mind: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

Yes, Jesus was divine, and yes, He was also human, but what really stuck in my mind was this question; "Could I, a mere human, one who is mortal, knowingly lay down my life for another?" The obvious answer, an answer which is caveated (for the consideration of a family member), is yes!

But, what about someone I don't know or have never seen, someone who is a total stranger? Well, that is what I was pondering. There are examples in society of people who do this, those in military service, the fire fighters and police, and a few others whose profession perhaps would put them in this position. And of course it is not a situation that they are in daily, in some instances it may never happen, but it is possible. But the question is "Could I do it? Would I do it?"

Consider if you had time to think about this, not a decision that is needed to be made immediately, but rather you are given time to reflect upon, to meditate upon, would you still have the same answer? More importantly, are you prepared to make this decision, is your soul prepared?

We probably have put too much thought into these questions. Perhaps if we consider a different approach, what is Love? I like this simple, appropriate explanation:

*"Love seeks one thing only; the good of the one loved. It leaves all the other secondary effects to take care of themselves. Love therefore, is its own reward."* – Thomas Merton.

Perhaps we would be better prepared if we followed this simple but powerful guidance.
