Perspective from the Pew



All members of the clergy vow obedience to their Bishop, and all his successors, but in a way, not only to him but to one another as well, and in particular to their elders. This goes way beyond doing what they're fold and requires an enormous amount of patience.

I have observed that preaching to strangers seems to be easier than preaching to my friends. The strangers do not know me as well as my friends do, but it's hard to think of anything serious to tell my friends.

I was asked to "preach" on the topic of love to a small group, and was at a loss for what to say to them, so I reached out to my spiritual director. When I arrived at his office, I knocked on the door, opened it, walked in, and found him napping. I gently nudged him, he opened his eyes, looked around the room for a moment, then simply said, "Tell them that there will come a day when she will want the window closed, and he will want the window open." Then he went back to sleep.

When it comes to living with someone, everything boils down to forgiveness. "Love is patient and kind . . . Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and *endures* all things" (1 Cor 13: 4-7, emphasis added).

So true love is more about endurance than it is about chocolates and teddy bears. We prove our love at precisely those moments when the people we love test our patience, put a strain on our kindness, and tempt us to anger. Love is truly love – and not just infatuation – when it proves itself in the crucible of suffering.

A Family Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank you for the gift of our family. Enlighten our hearts and minds that we may live more fully this vocation to love.

In our daily life and work, may we reflect the self-giving love which you, O Father, eternally show with your Son and the Holy Spirit.

Let your love be evident in the peace that reigns in our home and in the faith we profess and live. May our family always be a place of generosity, understanding, forgiveness and joy.


