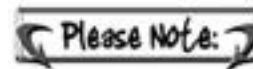

On April 13, 2017 Timothy Haley, age 26, died from an unknown heart issue while playing cards with friends. It was identified as a Fatal Ventricular Arrhythmia due to Cardiomegaly with Hypertrophy. His family and friends are hosting a benefit "Heart Check for Tim" on Saturday, May 15 from 10:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. at the K of C grounds.

This event will honor Timothy with a Wiffle Ball Tournament, Motorcycle Poker Run, Silent Auction, Basket Raffle, Food and Cash Bar.

This event is to raise awareness for unknown heart conditions and provide free on-site heart screenings for high school students by QMG. Our goal is to help prevent one family from going through the pain of losing a loved one as we have.

Part of the proceeds raised will go to the Tim Haley Fund with the Quincy Medical Group Foundation. It will help families who have children diagnosed with heart conditions who need medical care outside of our local community, for the expenses that come with travel. The other part of the proceeds will go to the Timothy L. Haley Scholarship Fund at QND. The Scholarship is given to a Senior or Seniors that played 3 sports during their 4 years at QND with the highest GPA.
